## 01 AIA|LA Design Awards

A panel of distinguished, innovative architects will review project entries to determine the best in architecture in Los Angeles, or by LA-based architects. Craig Dykers of Snøhetta in Oslo, Norway, and New York City, David Lake, FAIA, of Lake/Flato Architects in Austin, TX, and Enrique Norten, Hon. AIA, of TEN Arquitectos in New York City, will evaluate and judge projects in the categories listed below. Entrants should prepare their submission as a comprehensive chronicle of their design intentions and processes.

## PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

1. All entries must represent built projects that have been designed by either a **Los Angeles-based practice** or by other architects and located within the **area represented by the AIA Los Angeles Chapter**.
2. All entries must clearly identify the category in which the specific project should be considered.
3. Projects completed after **January 1, 2005**, are eligible.
4. Projects that have been awarded previously in the NEXT LA Awards are eligible for submission in any of the AIA/LA Design Award categories. Entries that have been awarded previously with an AIA/LA Design Award are not eligible for the 2008 AIA/LA Design Awards.
5. Projects by any 2008 AIA/LA Design Awards or NEXT LA Awards jury member (or that jury member's firm, regardless of location) **are not eligible**.

## 02 NEXT LA Awards

The NEXT LA Awards showcase the future of Los Angeles architecture. Winning projects will be chosen in the categories listed below by a panel of distinguished Los Angeles-based design professionals: Paul Danna, AIA, DMJM H&N; Julie Eizenberg, AIA, Koning Eizenberg Architecture; Qingyun Ma, AIA, University of Southern California School of Architecture; Michael Palladino, AIA, Richard Meier & Partners Architects; and Hraztan S. Zeitlian, AIA, Leo A. Daly. Entrants should prepare their submission as a comprehensive chronicle of their design intentions and processes.

## PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

1. All entries must represent projects that have been designed by either a **Los Angeles-based practice** or by other architects and located within the **area represented by the AIA Los Angeles Chapter**.
2. All entries must clearly identify the category in which the specific project should be considered.
3. All entries must be unbuilt, but have been commissioned by a client (except for Competitions, which must have been sponsored by a civic or professional organization for the purpose of selecting a project for construction). Projects and competitions must originate no earlier than **January 1, 2005**.
4. Projects must be **less than 75%** complete at time of judging to be eligible; jury maintains the right to disqualify projects that are more than 25% complete at time of judging.
5. Projects that have been awarded previously in the NEXT LA Awards are not eligible for submission in any of the other NEXT LA Awards categories.
6. Projects by any 2008 AIA/LA Design Awards or NEXT LA Awards jury member (or that jury member's firm, regardless of location) **are not eligible**.

## 03 Cultural Affairs Commission Design Awards

To gain greater awareness of and appreciation for city projects, AIA/LA is offering its Design/NEXT LA Awards entrants the option of submitting to the City of Los Angeles' Cultural Affairs Commission (CAC) Design Awards with the same entry materials. There is no additional cost to enter, but you must mark your entry accordingly.

Awards will be given for both built and unbuilt work in the categories listed below. The CAC Design Awards jury members are Daniel Dworsky, FAIA; Mehrdad Yazdani, Assoc. AIA, Yazdani Studio at Cannon Design; Lee Ramer, CAC Commissioner; Gayle Roski, CAC Commissioner; Simon Pastucha, City Planner, Planning Department's Urban Design Studio.

### ENTRY CATEGORIES

INSTITUTIONAL/CIVIC  
MULTI-UNIT RESIDENTIAL: PUBLIC HOUSING

### PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

1. All entries must represent projects that are built by the City of Los Angeles or in collaboration with a City of Los Angeles agency.
2. Projects must be designed by a city architect or private architecture firm from LA or outside of LA doing a project for the City.
3. All entries must clearly identify the category in which the specific project should be considered.
4. Projects that demonstrate the integration of public art and architecture are strongly encouraged.
5. For built work, projects completed after **January 1, 2005**, are eligible.
6. For unbuilt work, projects commissioned after **January 1, 2005**, that are **less than 75%** complete at time of judging, are eligible.
7. Projects do not have to be entered into the AIA/LA Design/NEXT LA Awards to be eligible, but must adhere to the AIA/LA Design/NEXT LA Awards format, rules, and schedule.
8. Projects that have previously won an AIA/LA Design Award or NEXT LA Award, and meet other CAC eligibility requirements, may be entered into CAC Design Awards only.
9. Projects receiving a CAC Design Award do not automatically receive an AIA/LA Design Award. Likewise, CAC-eligible projects receiving an AIA/LA Design Award do not automatically receive a CAC Design Award, although it is possible to win both a CAC Award and an AIA/LA Design Award.

Completed submittal boards must be received no later than 4:00 pm on April 25, 2008.

### 04. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Individuals or firms may submit any number of projects. An entry will be eligible even though the submitting architect is not the sole author, providing the submitting architect credits all other participants substantially contributing to the design of the project.

All entries must include:

- Presentation Board, including a range of images showing context and design
- 3 to 5 project digital images, a selection of which may be used during the Awards Ceremony and/or for publication and publicity

Detailed Submittal Requirements, including Category definitions and specifications for entry materials, etc., will be sent to all entrants upon registering.

### 05. JUDGING

The juries will gather on May 9, 2008, to evaluate projects for the AIA/LA Design Awards, the NEXT LA Awards, and the CAC Design Awards.

### 06. AWARDS GALA

This year's Awards Gala will be held on June 26, 2008. Winners of the awards will be announced at the Awards Gala, and will be given an award certificate.

In addition to honoring the winners of the AIA/LA Design Awards, NEXT LA Awards, and CAC Awards, the 2008 AIA/LA Presidential Award recipients will also be recognized. Tickets for the Awards Gala will be available for purchase through the Chapter office.

### 07. EXHIBITION + PUBLIC RECEPTION

All Awards Program participants will be on public exhibit - location and date to be announced.

A roundtable panel with select jury members is also being planned. Date and location to be announced.

### 08. PUBLICATION

All AIA/LA Design Award winners and NEXT LA Award winners will be published in the September/October 2008 issue of FORM. The information and images submitted will be used by the magazine.

### 09. FEES + DEADLINES

A non-refundable registration fee of \$185 (for AIA members) for the first entry into any of the competitions and \$155 for each additional entry into any of the competitions must accompany the entry form. Non-AIA member fees are \$255 and \$185, respectively. There is no fee for CAC Design Awards.
