## LEARNING OBJECTIVES: AIA CES: 4 LU

- 1. Participants will explore creative intersections by examining how Refik Anadol, Lita Albuquerque, and Lucy McRae blur boundaries between disciplines such as digital art, performance, sculpture, and fashion, expanding traditional definitions of creativity.
- 2. Participants will investigate cross-disciplinary collaboration by understanding how artists and architects can engage with one another to create new spatial, conceptual, and cultural experiences, especially in rapidly evolving creative ecosystems.
- 3. Participants will gain insight into architectural thinking by reflecting on how non-architectural disciplines approach space, narrative, and materiality—drawing inspiration for integrating these strategies into architectural practice.
- 4. Participants will examine the role of storytelling and the human experience in contemporary creative work, identifying how diverse mediums and perspectives convey meaning, evoke emotion, and shape public discourse.




